Air Quality Services

Permitting: Preparation of State applications and permit strategies to assist Construction, Operating (including Title V), and Synthetic Minor Permits; review of Draft Permits; Permit Applicability Determinations.

Federal Programs: Applicability determination and permitting assistance relative to Federal programs; Prevention of Significant Deterioration, New Source Review, New Source Performance Standards, National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants, and Compliance Assurance Monitoring.

Technology Determination: Analysis and preparation of determinations to accommodate Reasonably Available Control, Best Available Control, and Maximum Achievable Control Technologies.

Permit Compliance: Development of record keeping/reporting systems to effectively monitor and execute ongoing permit compliance; preparation of Semiannual Deviation Reports and Annual Compliance Certifications.

Compliance Auditing: Auditing of industrial facilities to evaluate regulatory compliance and provide corresponding recommendations for attainment and maintenance of compliance with Federal/State/local regulations.
